Discussion on the Salary Base increase. Some area schools are looking at a 6%-12% increase plus a bonus. Akron 10%, Idalia 9%, Flagler a 7% increase to their base salaries. When the mill levy override was passed it was for transportation fleet and to keep staff and stay competitive with salaries. This will be revisited in April board meeting.

Consolidated Grant Application – EC BOCES submits this application for our district and the funds then flow through the BOCES to us with professional development, title I salary support, Title VI – help with Jesse's salary. Information the Board needs to know if audited. Districts can opt out, but would have to provide these services themselves.
